Dear Parents-

Today, your child attended a demonstration of instruments that will be offered at **Father Doyle School** through the Paul Effman Music Service in the coming year. PEM will offer:

- Violin for students in grades K (minimum age 5) through 8
- Viola for students in grades 3-8 (pending successful sizing of instrument), best to indicate a 2nd choice on form
- Cello for students in grades 2-8 (pending successful sizing of instrument), best to indicate a 2nd choice on form
- Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Bells, or Drums for students in grades 3-8
- Also Bass Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone, French Horn, and Baritone Horn for experienced students

Lessons at Father Doyle will be held on **Thursdays after school**. Once registrations are received, our faculty assigns students into groups based on their instrument and level of experience. You will receive an initial schedule for lessons via our **September Letter**. There will be three schedule updates: a **November, February, and April Letter** as groups change/consolidate, with any make-up dates due to teacher absence or school cancellation, as lessons lengthen as we approach concerts, and details pertaining to performances. Experienced students generally perform in both December and in the Spring, while beginners will only perform in the Spring. Concert dates and times will be forwarded by email and through schedule updates.

Email is a very effective means of communication for our faculty! PEM provides lessons at 10 Catholic Schools across RI impacting more than 300 students each year. As such, we ask that you program our faculty into your "contacts" so we are assured our emails reach you and we don't end up in SPAM/JUNK folders. OCTOBER 1, 2018: Instrument Night...SOMETHING NEW!!!

On Monday- October 1, PEM will provide a parent meeting and Instrument Night at St. Rose of Lima School: 200 Brentwood Ave, Warwick, RI 02886 at 6:30pm. Through this meeting, our faculty will provide families with some general information to help their students through the school year as many take on new instruments or continue their studies. We'll go over tips to assist students at home, ideas on how to set up a practice routine, and we'll also distribute rental instruments, September Schedules, and lesson folders. **We highly encourage at least one parent/guardian to attend!** If you pre-registered your student last spring or over the summer, please join us for the parent meeting anyway.

What if you already own an instrument or rent elsewhere?

We are more than happy to work with students who wish to use a family owned instrument, but we caution that it's always a good idea to bring family instruments to a qualified music repair shop to be evaluated first. Students will feel success quickly with an instrument in **good-working-order**, but also can be very discouraged if their instrument doesn't function properly. We highly recommend renting, rather than purchasing an instrument if your student is an absolute beginner. Rental instruments from PEM and other reputable retailers are solid student instruments made by quality makers. Unfortunately, many instruments available for purchase at low-cost online or at local music and department stores will not lead to student success and cause much frustration along the way! If you are unsure about the brand or model of an instrument that is either being "gifted" to your student or available for purchase at a low cost—please **BEWARE**, and feel free to check with us by sending an email at any time! You can also bring a family-owned instrument, borrowed instrument, or instruments rented elsewhere to the Instrument Night to be evaluated.

MORE about REGISTRATION and FEES...

We realize there is a lot of information on the PEM registration form. We'd like to break it down a bit for you...

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- At the top of the form, please select the instrument your child wishes to study and how you plan to acquire the instrument
- If you do not see the instrument listed, please check OTHER and write in the name of the instrument such as French Horn, Baritone, Tenor Saxophone, etc.
 - *Please be reminded that PEM does not offer piano or guitar; however- if your child plays piano, please consider having them sign up for bells, a percussion instrument set up just like the piano!*
- Our string instrument vendor Beekman Violin in Wakefield, RI has a limited number of small violas and cellos; we will fill rental orders on a first come-first serve basis. If we cannot fill your rental request, your child will have the option to start lessons on violin and the rental fee will be adjusted, or we will refer you to another local rental company and your rental fee will be refunded or applied to tuition. We will call any family impacted by this situation personally.
- Students who select violin, viola or cello will be visited in late September by our staff to size them correctly; we will set this time with the school office and your child will be called from class for a 5-minute sizing session.
- To fully register your child/children, you are asked to provide payment for:
 - *Tuition Installment #1*
 - *A Registration Fee, which covers all printed materials provided to the student during the year*
 - *The full cost of any instruments rented/purchased through PEM*
- If you are renting or purchasing an instrument, complete the back side of the registration form with all prices
- You can either pay by check or by entering credit card information.
 - ***If you check the yellow box*** monthly tuition will be charged to this card
 - ***If you DO NOT check the yellow box***, initial payment will be processed by credit, but you will be provided with a sheet of coupons in order to make monthly installment payments by mail
 - *To simplify things, the full tuition for 30 thirty-minute lessons plus concerts is divided into 10 installments; the first installment is due upon registration and 9 more payments are made throughout the year. There are some months where only 2-3 lessons are given, but other months involve up to 5*
- If it's easier, you can also register your child online at **PEMUSIC.com**
- If you submit a registration form, please **print** contact information clearly to avoid data-entry errors.

Thank you for your time and we hope this letter helps to clarify the registration process and how PEM lessons fit into your school community. Step 3: Program, Schedule, & Tuition Details

The Band Program is available to students in grades 3-8, with or without experience. Half hour small group lessons given after school on Thursdays. Lesson schedule begins at dismissal. You will receive your assigned lesson time prior to the 1st lesson. Not all Students will be scheduled at dismissal.

Violin is offered to students in grades K (age 5+) through 8.

The annual tuition is divided into nine monthly installments. The first installment and the Registration Fee are due with this form. The remaining eight installments are due on the last day of each month. You will receive a payment coupon sheet. These installments may be paid by credit card automatically. You can prepay some or all installments at any time. The monthly tuition installment amounts are:

\$62 per month for 1 child • \$102 per month for 2 children • \$124 per month for 3 children • \$10 for each child exceeding 3

1. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR EARLY INSTRUMENT RETURNS.
2. Tuition payments are due on the last day of each month. Late payments are subject to an annual late fee not exceeding \$30. Failure to make timely payments may result in removal from the program and early rental instrument collection. There is a \$25 fee for all returned checks.
3. I agree to pay the replacement value for lost or stolen instruments. Snare Drum Kits and Bell Kits are \$217.24. Baritone Saxophone and Tuba are \$1500. Alto Saxophone and specialized instruments are \$550. All other instruments are \$275.
4. I agree to return the rental instrument on or before the last lesson during the 2018-2019 school year. I agree to be responsible for missing parts, broken mouthpieces, broken drum heads (\$20), willful damage, vandalism, loss or theft of instrument. I agree to pay a \$30 late fee if I return my instrument after June 30, 2019.
5. I agree to return the rental instrument in good condition, as when received less normal wear.
6. I understand that photos of concerts and/or classes could be used on the Paul Effman Music Service website or school websites.
